#### Why plant trees with hinter live?

Filmed in the wild, hinter live is a new live music content that aims to be the crossroads between environmentalism and live music. The Canadian company based in Montréal is launching a year long campaign of live performances shot in different National Parks across Canada, each session plants over 500 trees in forest in need by the NGO one tree planted.

### **Reforestation in British Columbia**

Over the past few years we have seen an increase in the severity and frequency of forest fires. While forest fires are a part of mother nature's process, their increasing severity around the world is leading to a significant negative impact for nature, people, and wildlife.

But the good news is that planting trees is one of the best ways to help these ecosystems recover!

This project aims to restore forests after fires that occurred in British Columbia in 2017, which consumed 230,000 hectares of land. Aiding in the restoration process by planting trees will help speed up recovery while providing habitat for wildlife.

### **hinter.** LIVE 2024 Artist Residence Program

We are launching a new artist residency program that consist on a <u>3 day songwriting and music production camp.</u>

Teaming up **hinter company**, we provide an artistic facility in the **Quebec countryside**, **2** hours away from Montréal where artist can be inspired and create for **3 days and 3 nights** with top producers, and at the same time take part in workshops on eco-responsibility and sustainable practices in the arts.



We will set up **portable studios** in one of our chalets where artist and producers can create while profiting for nature.

We will set up different rooms adequate for songwriting and music production.

Artist will also be able to do **field recordings** in the outdoors to generate immersive sounds, samples and **create music with the sounds** of nature.

Artist and Producers will live in the forest for the duration of the residency while learn about ecology, sustainability and eco-responsibility in the arts as part of this residency.

The artist residence is exclusively a **creation residency** that will be filmed and released as a **fase 2 of our web series**.

A fase 3 of this project will consists on the **public exhibition and commercial** release of the works made at the residency. This will require the support of **festivals**, **museums and immersive galleries** to show these works and record labels who choose to distribute the recordings Thank you!
